Private Vehicle Disclaimer Form

There will be circumstances where the number of students representing ATU at a representative event or intervarsity competition is such that the cost of bus hire is prohibitive. In such instances use of public transport is advised, but there will also be times where that is not available or considered by the Clubs and Societies Operational Committee to be inappropriate (e.g. transporting equipment). In those circumstances a private vehicle /car may be used, and the driver reimbursed 100% of the overall fuel rate, as calculated from Fuel Cost Calculator Ireland from ATU Sligo to competition venue, subject to the following conditions:

- Use of personal vehicles is at the student's own risk.
- All rules of the road and those pertaining to safety will be fully adhered to.
- The driver is responsible for the safety of the passengers in their car and must ensure that the car is roadworthy, not 'overloaded' and that the correct insurance is in place.
- It is the responsibility of each student travelling to ensure that the car and driver are insured and that the car itself is roadworthy and driven only by a licensed driver.
- In the event of an accidents where there is a possible or probable injury, the emergency services should be contacted at 999/112.
- Under no circumstances should the driver be under the influence of alcohol or other drugs whilst driving (this includes driving the day after a 'night out').
- Whilst representing ATU and travelling to and from such events, all students are bound by the Student Code.
